Since that meeting, several other provisions have been identified in the House Tax Act that could adversely impact cities and many of its citizens. The National League of Cities (NLC) has requested that its member organization join them in expressing their concerns to Congress. Not only does this Act impact the 4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credit, but it also eliminates advance refunding authorization; New Market Tax Credits and Historic Tax Credits; and State and Local Tax Deductions. Each of these eliminations could significantly impact the City of Winston-Salem and many of its citizens. The attached resolution replaces the original resolution and authorizes the City of Winston-Salem to join NLC in expressing our local concerns to Congress.
