**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM
PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, Winston-Salem Department of Transportation (WSDOT) staff has worked with a consultant, Alta Planning + Design, since early 2020 to develop a new Winston-Salem Pedestrian Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the final plan identifies priority corridors and intersections requiring infrastructure improvements, as well as programs and policies to improve the walking environment; and

WHEREAS, the planning process included the formation of a steering committee composed of over twenty-five departments and external agencies to develop the vision, objectives, and goals for the plan; and

WHEREAS, the ensuing data analysis and objective corridor prioritization process flowed directly from the steering committee's vision; and

WHEREAS, the consultant team implemented an iterative public input process that accounted for the challenges of collecting feedback during a pandemic and included an online interactive map, virtual public input meetings, personal interviews, social media posts, and postcard mailings to ensure input from underrepresented groups; and

WHEREAS, the resulting plan is a living document providing a method to prioritize investments in pedestrian infrastructure that can be modified to adapt to changing priorities.
