Summary of Information:

Due to the recent work on Peters Creek Parkway adjacent to Truist Stadium, concerns have been raised about the impact this work will have on the fan's perception in regards to food safety as well as the impact on the overall fan experience. To address the issue, the City, in conjunction with Winston-Salem Dash staff, proposes to install fencing that would effectively screen the fans from the area of concern. This fencing would begin at the VIP entrance off Peters Creek Parkway and would extend to the end of the ballpark canopy along the third base side, consisting of six (6) bays of 8' tall solid fencing, in a saddle color, between brick columns.

Bids were received July 10, 2020, for the installation of screen fencing, per specifications and the following bids were received:
