Summary of Information:

The Winston-Salem Department of Transportation (WSDOT) received a street mural application from the Winston-Salem Public Art Commission on behalf of Elizabeth Coyne and Sarah Snider for the installation of an artistic crosswalk design within an existing crosswalk. This piece by Elizabeth Coyne and Sarah Snider was selected by the Public Art Commission following the 2023 open public art call. The application received for this mural indicates the design would be painted within the existing crosswalk located at the intersection of Hawthorne Road and Northwest Boulevard. The proposed location and rendering of the mural can be found on the attached documentation. Staff representing the Public Art Commission submitted the necessary application and supporting documentation for painting within the public right-of-way.
