

WINSTON-SALEM POLICE GUN SEIZURES

- ► WSPD seized over 1000 Firearms each year in 2020 and 2021.
- ► As of 06-09-2022, WSPD has already seized 509 Firearms

► WSPD anticipates seizing over 1000 Firearms in 2022

Gun Buyback Initiatives

- November 2021
 - ► 252 Handguns
 - ▶ 108 Long Guns (Shotguns, Rifles)
 - ▶ 7 Assault Weapons
- ▶ January 2022
 - ▶ 329 Handguns
 - ▶ 177 Long Guns (Shotguns, Rifles)
 - ▶ 10 Assault Weapons
- ► City Council authorized spending over \$119,000 to obtain Unwanted Firearms


