Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing an Agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Barbara Jane Avenue Sidewalk Project (East Ward)

**Summary of Information:**

The City has plans to construct a sidewalk on Barbara Jane Avenue from Old Greensboro Road to Woodrow Powell Drive. The total estimated cost of this project is \$345,500. On May 17, 2018, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Advisory Committee approved the use of \$52,800 in Surface Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funds for design to supplement \$171,200 in Federal funding approved through The North Carolina Department of Transportation's (NCDOT) Prioritization process 3.0 bringing the total federal amount to \$224,000. All Federal funds require a local match, which is being provided by the City.

The attached resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the NCDOT, whereby the City will design and construct the project and NCDOT will reimburse the City for all eligible project expenses, up to \$228,800. The City's local match of \$121,500 is available from 2014 Bond Funds, which is already appropriated.
