## Monitoring

- FY22 Community Project Funding Appropriation / Parking Deck Lights Project (under HUD) – *The project is to add/replace lights in a parking deck. The project was endorsed by Congresswoman Manning and received funding (\$190,000) in the FY22 appropriations bill.* – HUD requires funds to be obligated by 2027.
- FY23 Community Project Funding Appropriation / Runnymede Water Infrastructure Project (under EPA) – *The project is for water infrastructure improvements along and near Runnymede. The project was endorsed by Congresswoman Manning and received funding (\$2,800,000) in the FY23 appropriations bill.* – EPA guidance for FY23 grants is available [here](#).
- USDOT RAISE Grant Program / Long Branch Trail Project ([DTOS59-22-RA-RAISE](#)) – *The City received a \$6,000,000 grant for this project.* – USDOT requires funds to be spent by June 2028.
- FY24 Community Project Funding Appropriation / BEAR Team Expansion (under DOJ) – *The project is to support additional BEAR Team personnel. The project was endorsed by Congresswoman Manning and received \$700,000 in funding in the FY24 appropriations bill.* – Guidance for this CPF project comes from the DOJ Byrne JAG Program and is available [here](#).

## FY26 Community Project Funding / Congressionally Directed Spending

- FY26 Community Project Funding (CPF) Appropriation Request – *The City's FY26 CPF request for the WSFD security upgrades project was submitted by Congressman McDowell under the HUD Economic Development Initiative account to the House Appropriations Committee to receive further consideration for fiscal year 2026 funding. The WSFD project was not selected by the House Transportation-HUD appropriations subcommittee bill for FY26 CPF funding.* – Strategics has connected with congressional staff about the FY26 appropriations process to plan for and improve CPF request submissions for the next round.
