Resolution Awarding Contract for Structural Repairs to The Gemeinhaus and Butner House (Distillery House) at Historic Bethabara Park (Northwest Ward)

Strategic Focus Area: Livable Neighborhoods

Summary of Information:

The Gemeinhaus tower has been leaking since it was installed in 1788, so much that in 1808 it was completely removed from the building, slightly redesigned, and reinstalled. Water infiltration at the tower recently caused a large area of the Saal ceiling to fall that can be unsafe for the citizens using this facility. Because of the water-related repairs needed at Bethabara Park, design and construction repairs to the Gemeinhaus tower are of the highest priority.

The Butner House (Distillery House) has undertaken water above and below that has irreparably damaged the Distillery front porch. Failing roofing has allowed water to enter the porch from above damaging the roof structure, porch ceiling, columns, and porch decking. The porch needs to be removed from the building, reconstructed, and reinstalled.

Because these buildings are protected under the City's historic preservation ordinance and on the National Register of Historic Places, it is recommended that a contract be awarded in an amount not to exceed \$350,000, to a licensed contractor for the rehabilitation of the buildings with historic preservation experience.
