Phase 1 Funding History (Completed)

- Original Commitment (Spread amongst all phases)
 - \$3,000,000 General Obligation Bonds (GO Bonds)
 - \$3,000, 000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Phase 1 81 Units
 - \$1,844,440 GO Bonds
 - \$1,500,000 CDBG
 - \$586,000 Economic Development Funds
 - \$500,000 HOME Investment Partnership Funds

Total - \$4,430,440 (City Gap Financing)




Phase 2 Funding History (In-Progress)

- Phase 2 72 Units
 - \$4,495,344 ARPA Housing Development Funds
 - \$2,899,798 Economic Development Funds
 - \$500,000 HOME Investment Partnership
 - \$375,000 CDBG
 - \$288,890 GO Bonds
- Total \$8,559,032 (City Gap Financing)
- Total Development Cost \$37,098,244
- Current Gap \$3,751,629



Phase 3 Funding History (In-Progress)

- Phase 3 42 Units
 - \$281,250 CDBG
 - \$216,668 GO Bonds
- Total \$497,918
- Total Development Cost \$16,707,245
- Current Gap \$1,746,440

- \$3,400,000 Economic Development Funds
- \$3,000,000 CDBG
- \$3,000,000 GO Bonds
- \$1,000,000 HOME Investment Ent Partnership

Total - \$14,895,344

Funding Request

- The Housing Authority of Winston-Salem (HAWS) formally requests \$3,000,000 of additional Affordable Housing Funds to assist in closing the \$5.5M gap for phases 2 and 3
- How will HAWS close the remaining gap if this gets approved?
 - Consolidating construction costs and other applicable fees for phases 2 and 3
 - Refinancing phase 1 to use the costs savings for access to additional capital
 - Requesting HUD to authorize the use of additional CNI Funds
