**Summary of Information:**

The Department of Transportation received a request to install one on-street handicap parking space at a residence in front of 1448 West Fourth Street.

Ms. Melody Edwards and Mr. Charles Leanza, both legally blind, requested one on-street handicap parking space at this location. The handicap space will provide accessibility for Trans-Aid and other transport services which they rely on for transportation to appointments multiple days each week. Without having these handicap spaces these transport providers have to park down the street which makes it difficult for Ms. Edwards and Mr. Leanza to access the vehicles. This space will provide better accessibility for them.

The Department of Transportation recommends the installation of one on-street handicap parking space at 1448 W. Fourth Street. The resident has submitted all required information per Section 42-154 City Code relating to handicap parking (adopted September 2017). A map is attached.
