Resolution Awarding Purchase Order for Conventional Day Cab with Hook Lift Hoist Body

## **Summary of Information:**

Vegetation Management has budgeted to replace a 2001 Chevrolet C7 with 111,559 miles, acquired cost of \$72,059.80, and accrued maintenance and repair costs of \$44,084.49. This truck is used for watering, transporting of trees and shrubs, and brush collection City-wide.

Purchasing advertised a formal bid for the purchase of a conventional day cab with hook lift hoist body, and five bids meeting specifications were received on October 25, 2023, as follows:

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Lilley International for the purchase of an International MV chassis with Swaploader hook lift body at a cost of \$176,495.00.

The FY 2023-24 capital equipment budget includes sufficient funds for this purchase, which will be financed through the City's internal leasing program.
