**RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL  
AGREEMENT WITH FORSYTH COUNTY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE BRUSHY  
FORK CREEK STREAMBANK RESTORATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS** under Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, as amended (the “Interlocal Act”), cities and counties are authorized to enter into interlocal cooperation undertakings with other local governments for the joint exercise of any power, function, public enterprise, right, privilege, or immunity of local governments in North Carolina; and

**WHEREAS** the purpose of this Agreement is to provide the terms of the relationship between the City and the County with respect to participation in the Brushy Fork Creek streambank restoration project which focuses on the rehabilitation of approximately 2,100 linear feet of streambank situated between Smith Reynolds Airport and Northwood Estates; and

**WHEREAS** the County received a grant from the North Carolina Land and Water Fund in the amount of \$300,000 to assist with the project and the County will be responsible for the management and contracting work associated with the project; and

**WHEREAS** the City agrees to contribute \$300,000 toward the Brushy Fork Creek streambank restoration project; and

**WHEREAS** the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners approved the Agreement at their meeting on November 16, 2023.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and City Council of Winston-Salem do hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into an interlocal agreement with
