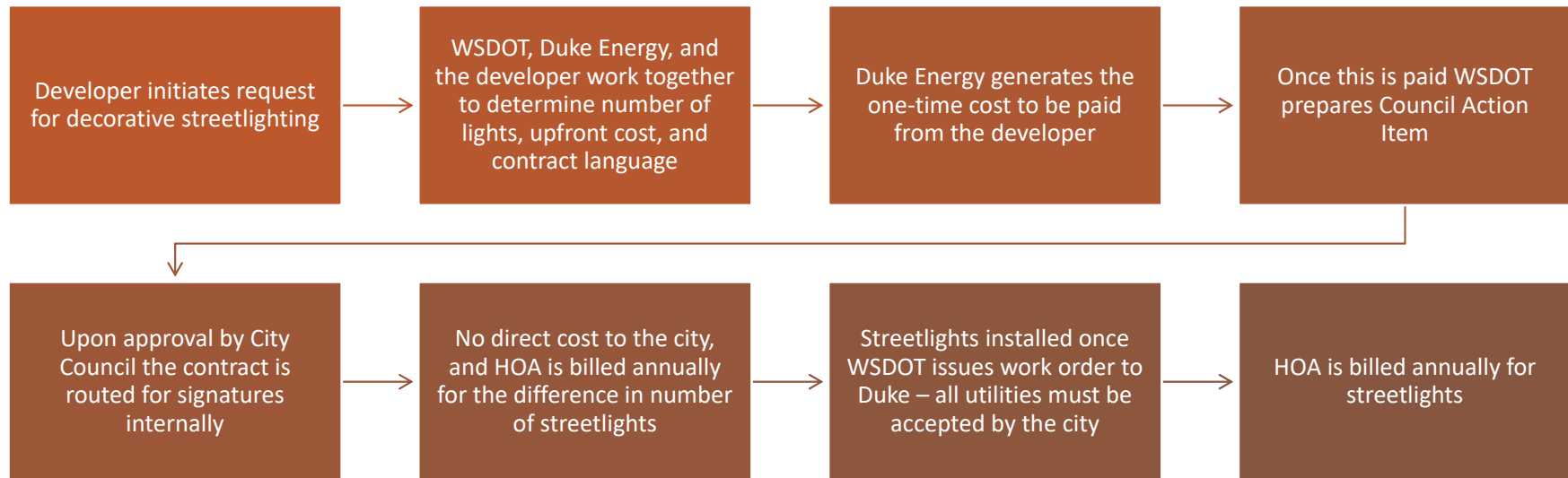


Decorative Streetlight Policy

Developer reached out to city May 23, 2023 to initiate the process. The phase of development already had home built and residents living in homes



Developer paid the decorative adder on 10-23-23

This is the last step the city needs to enter contract with the developer/HOA



WSDOT prepares council items – due to timing it went on the November City Council Schedule – Approved November 27, 2023

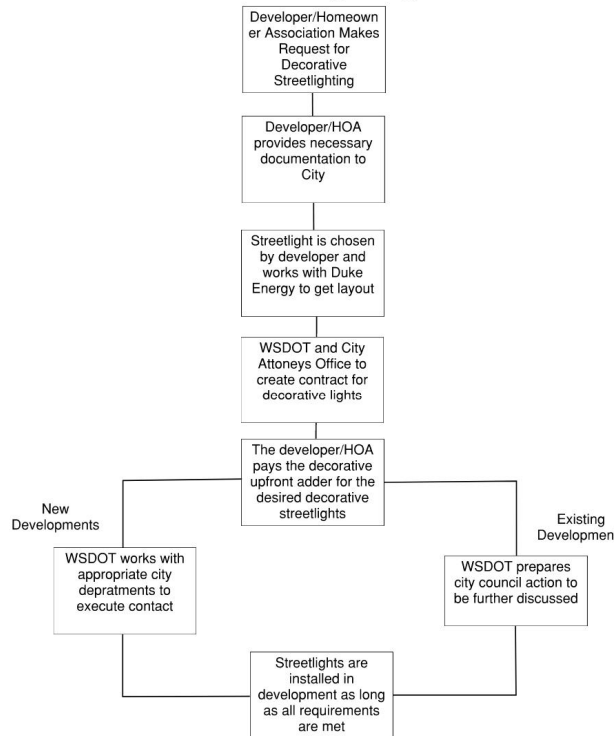


Lights installed mid-January 2024



Staff fielded calls from residents that were concerned over when the lights would be installed

Decorative Streetlighting Workflow



Updates to Policy

Allows staff to enter contract with appropriate parties without approval from committee/council

- Saves staff around 30-45 days of wait time
- Allows developer to pay up front adder before contract execution
- Allows for a more streamlined process when getting contracts executed
- Reduces number of calls regarding status of streetlights
- Decrease in supply chain issues

Committee/Council will still be notified if it is for an existing neighborhood and staff is recommending a decorative contract
