The Police Department's Gang Unit is staffed with specially trained officers who are responsible for validating and monitoring known and suspected gang members. The unit also conducts follow-up investigations and surveillance, and provides community presentations.

The Winston-Salem Gang Steering Committee

The Winston-Salem Gang Steering Committee comprises representatives of local non-profit organizations, pastors, mental health professionals and police and criminal justice personnel who work together to coordinate the city's initiatives to fight gangs.

Action Teams:

The Prevention/Intervention Community Action Team focuses on working with individuals (and their families) who are in gangs or at risk. The team creates a personalized intervention plan for every individual with whom they work.

The Law Enforcement-Suppression and Education Action Team works to suppress gang activity and provides gang-awareness training.

The Clergy/Counseling Community Action Team provides services to address the mental and emotional needs of individuals (and their families) who are in gangs or at risk.

The Gang Steering Committee is not set up to accept direct applications from individuals or families seeking assistance.
