**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH DAVIDSON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION FOR THE RECEIPT
OF FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5307 FUNDING FOR
FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2021 FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 funds are appropriated to urban areas with more than 200,000 in population and are used for operating and capital assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem's Urbanized Area receives a full appropriation of the FTA, Section 5307 funding in the amount of \$5,218,153 for FFY 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem is the designated recipient of this funding for the Winston-Salem Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) approved the 2021 apportionments to the three eligible sub-recipients and Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) services for funding; and

WHEREAS, Winston-Salem Transit Authority receives \$4,443,605, JARC services will utilize a total of \$55,000 and the Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) receives \$579,407; and

WHEREAS, Davidson County Transportation was approved to receive \$186,957 in FFY 2021; and

WHEREAS, Davidson County Transportation will be a sub-recipient to the City of Winston-Salem for these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorizes the City Manager and City Clerk to execute an
