Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Approve the Federal Transit Administration Fiscal Year 2021 Section 5307 Formula Funding Sub-Allocation or Split Letter for the Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation

Summary of Information:
The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 funds are appropriated to urban areas with more than 200,000 in population and are used for operating and capital assistance.

The Winston-Salem Urban area has received a full appropriation of the FTA FY 2021 Section 5307 Formula funding in the amount of \$5,218,153 for FY 2021. The City of Winston-Salem is the designated recipient of this funding for the Winston-Salem Urban area. At the March 2021 Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) meeting, the Winston-Salem Urban Area TAC approved the 2021 apportionment to the three eligible sub-recipients and to the JARC agencies for funding: the Winston-Salem Transit Authority receives \$4,443,605, the Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) receives \$579,407, Davidson County Transportation receives \$168,957 and JARC agencies receive \$55,000.

Davidson County Transportation will serve as a sub-recipient to the City of Winston-Salem. However, as a current direct recipient of FTA funding, PART is eligible to apply directly to FTA for its portion of the Section 5307 funds if the City of Winston-Salem issues a sub-allocation or split letter so that they can apply to receive these funds.
