## **Summary of Information**:

Through its enforcement efforts, the Forsyth County DWI Task Force has accumulated enough points from the North Carolina Governor's Highway Safety Program (GHSP) to redeem them for a partial purchase of a Chevrolet Tahoe. This large utility vehicle will be used to tow various trailers used during checkpoints and transport equipment to other traffic safety events throughout the year. The purchase will be partially funded using GHSP points, with the remaining balance due paid using previously appropriated North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation (NCMLC) funds. Execution of a local government resolution is required in order to proceed with redeeming GHSP points. A breakdown of the costs is as follows:
