Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee Meeting

Historic Resources staff has reviewed the 5 properties that are scheduled to go before the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee on February 12, 2019 for demolition consideration. None of the buildings are Local Historic Landmarks or located within local historic districts.

Properties located in National Register Historic Districts:
709 Goldfloss Street – **Waughtown-Belview Historic District**

Generally, Historic Resources staff has concerns about the loss of structures in the City's National Register Historic Districts. However, the Community Development Department reports that this house has burned. If demolition for this structure is approved, Historic Resources staff requests that the Community Development Department have the structures professionally photo-documented and submit the photos to the Forsyth County Historic Resources Commission.

Recent discussions at City Council and Council Committee meetings have indicated a concern for the loss of structures in historically African-American neighborhoods. For Council Members' information, I have identified structures from the list that are in historically African-American neighborhoods, as documented by the latest survey of Winston-Salem's historic resources.
