NOVEMBER 10, 2020

COLLECTION CYCLES



BRUSH COLLECTION

Collected one quadrant at a time, working in a clockwise direction.

Brush should not exceed 6 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length.

Year round collection.



LEAF COLLECTION

Collection began Nov 2nd in quadrant 2.

Collected one quadrant at a time, working in a clockwise direction.

Three rounds of leaf collection.



BULKY ITEM

Suspended until further notice due to the impact of the COVID-19 virus.

Accepted items: appliances, carpet, furniture, mattresses, toys.

One collection per neighborhood.



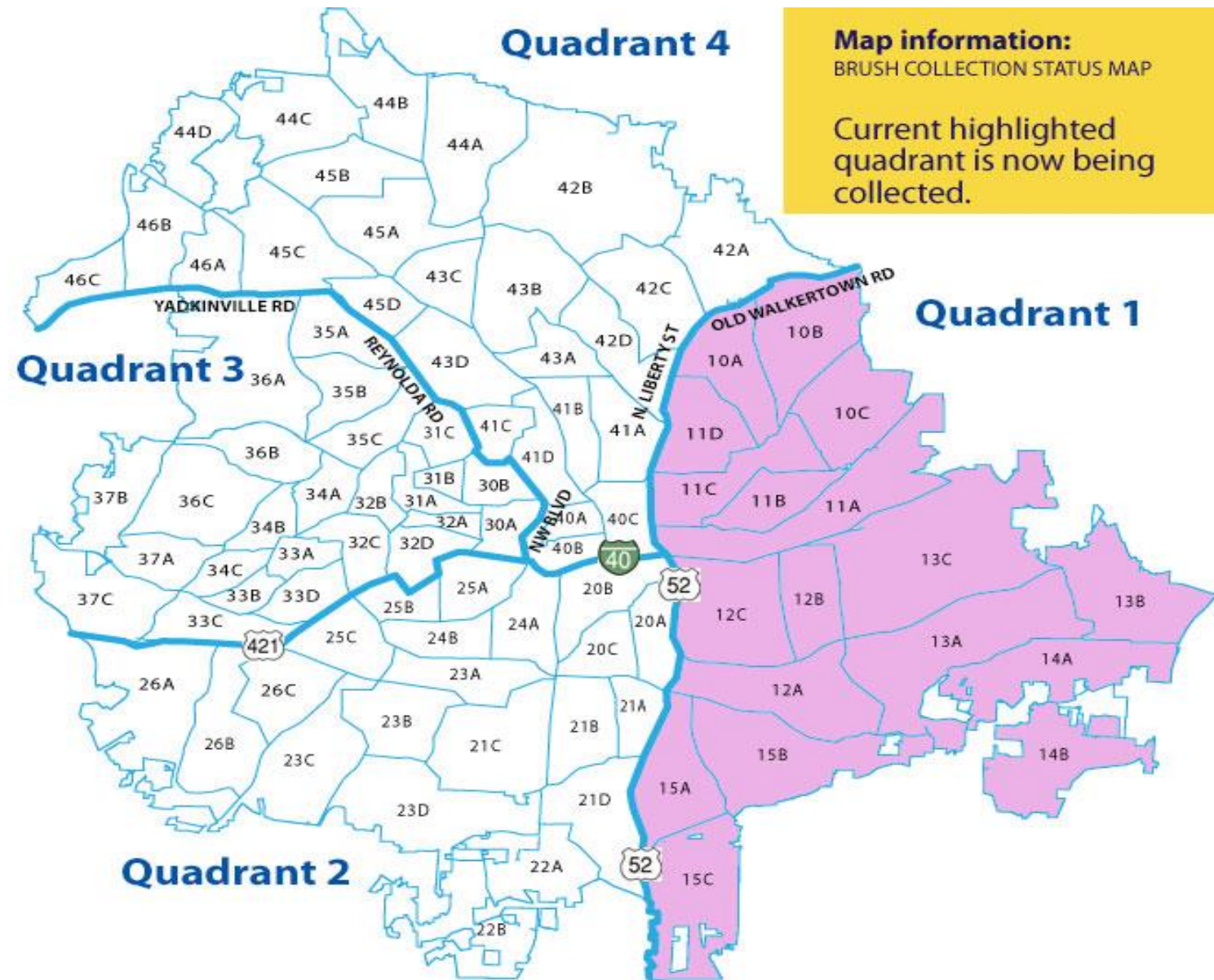
REFUSE

Weekly collection to Winston-Salem residents.

Carts should be at curb by 6am on the day of collection, and no earlier than 5pm the day before collection.

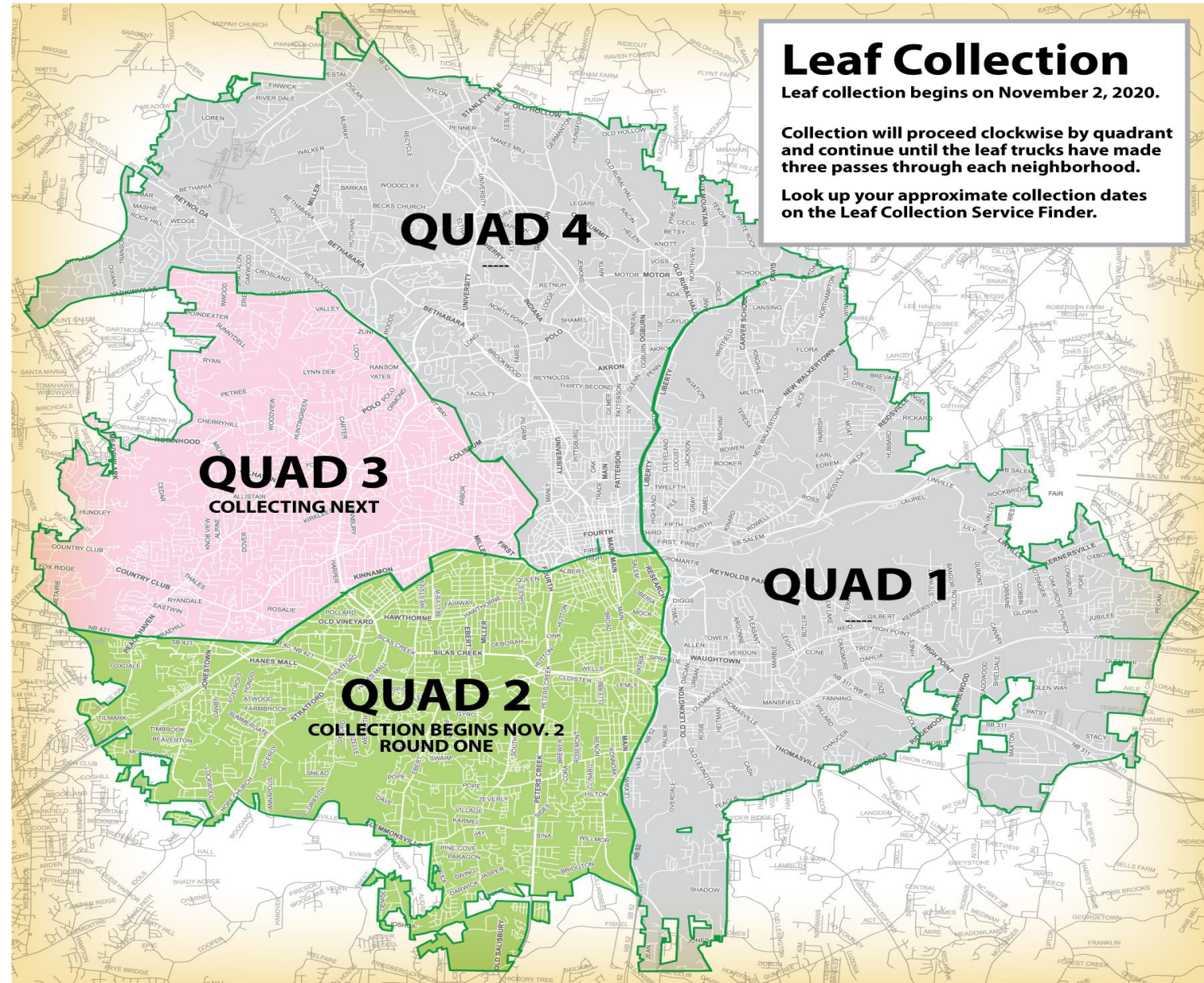
BRUSH COLLECTION

- Brush collection was suspended for 9 weeks in April and May due to Covid-19.
- Frontline employees have been working six days a week since their return.
- Brush collection is limited from the start of leaf season until mid- January.
- 5 hoist trucks and 4 scow beds have been assigned to brush collection.



LEAF COLLECTION

- 28 temporary employees began working on November 2nd
- We currently have 7 out of 10 automated leaf trucks and 16 out of 18 rear-pull trucks in use.
- Crews will begin working 9 hours Monday through Friday mid-November.
- Leaf collection will be added to Saturday routes around December 5th.



HURRICANE ZETA EFFORTS

VEGETATION MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE

10/29/20- 3 hoist trucks and 6 frontline employees

10/30/20- 2 hoist trucks and 4 frontline employees

11/2/20- 2 hoist trucks, 2 scow beds, and 6 frontline employees

11/3/20- 2 hoist trucks and 6 frontline employees

During the first 4 days following the storm 176 hours were worked by Sanitation Division crews to help clear downed trees and debris.

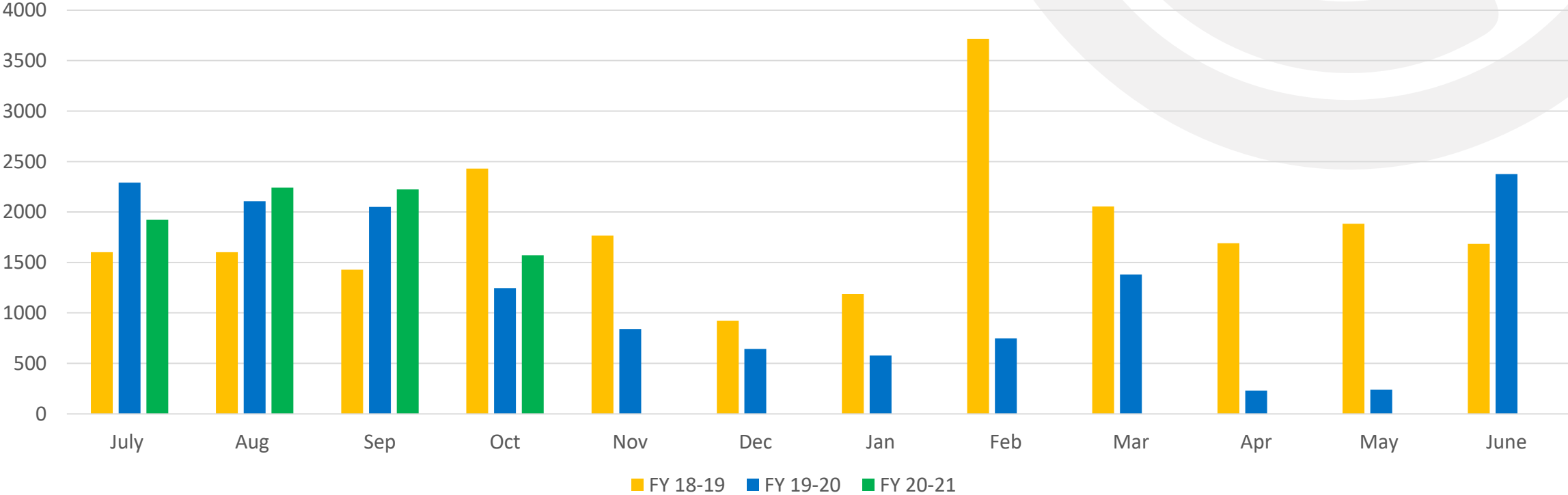
All brush and leaf collections will take place as scheduled.

Sanitation frontline crews will continue to assist with Hurricane Zeta relief efforts as needed.

Crews will be assigned efficiently with the least amount of impact on operations.
