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## RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER FOR PUMPER EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Fire Department has the need to purchase new pumper equipment which includes hose, nozzles, thermal imager, self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA), forcible entry tools, fans, and saws, which will allow a pumper being replaced to move into reserve status as a stocked unit; and

WHEREAS, bids for the equipment needed were received May 6, 2020, as listed below:
