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**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR  
MINERAL SPRINGS TENNIS COURT RECONSTRUCTION**

**WHEREAS**, after proper advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by City/County Purchasing at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 29, 2020, for Mineral Springs Tennis Court Reconstruction and the following bids were received:

**WHEREAS**, the low bidder, Court One, submitted M/WBE subcontracting goals below those established for this project and failed to make the sufficient good faith effort as determined by the Citizen's M/WBE Advisory Committee, which renders their bid non-responsive and cannot be considered for award; and

**WHEREAS**, the next lowest bidder, Ruston Paving Co., Inc., exceeded the M/WBE subcontracting goals established for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a contract be awarded to Ruston Paving Co., Inc., the lowest bidder meeting specifications, for Mineral Springs Tennis Court Reconstruction in the total amount of \$138,500.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that the contract for Mineral Springs Tennis Court Reconstruction is hereby awarded to Ruston Paving Co., Inc. in the total amount of \$138,500 and all other bids rejected. The City Manager and City Secretary are authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City, with the contract to be approved by the City Attorney.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until the contract is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Ruston Paving Co., Inc. will be required to subcontract at a minimum 1.2% of this contract with certified minority-owned businesses and 19.0% with certified women-owned businesses as indicated on the Affidavit “C” submitted by the company.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that funds have been previously appropriated in the FY19-20 budget from the 2018 G.O. Bond to cover the cost of this contract.
