RESOLUTION ORDERING THE CLOSING AND ABANDONMENT OF <u>AN UNNAMED ALLEY BETWEEN</u>

BRENT STREET AND S. SUNSET DRIVE

WHEREAS, on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of <u>February 2024</u>, a petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, to close <u>an unnamed alley between Brent Street and S. Sunset Drive</u>, as described on the next page; and

**WHEREAS**, on the  $6^{th}$  day of May 2024, at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, a resolution fixing the date and hour for the hearing on

said petition was adopted by unanimous vote of said City Council; and the date and hour were fixed on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 2024, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, Second Floor of City Hall in the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, notice of said meeting was published once a week for four successive weeks in the Winston-Salem Journal, a newspaper published in the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, pursuant to order of the City Council in the resolution fixing the date for hearing on the above-described petition and notice of the closing and public hearing was posted in at least two prominent places along said portions of said street proposed to be closed; and

**WHEREAS**, at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 2024, a public hearing was held on the petition to close and abandon said unnamed alley between Brent Street and S. Sunset Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, notice, if required under GS 160A-299, was given to the State Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the satisfaction of the City Council of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, that the closing of the indicated portion of said <u>unnamed alley between Brent Street and S. Sunset Drive</u> is not contrary to the public interest and that no other individual owning property

adjoining, abutting or in the vicinity of said right-of-way will thereby be deprived of reasonable

means of ingress and egress to his property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City

of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, that portion of the unnamed alley between Brent Street and S.

Sunset Drive as herein referred to, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Tax PIN 6825-61-8971 and the western right-of-way of S. Sunset Drive, thence west, with the southern

property line of Tax PINs 6825-61-8971, 6825-61-8912, 6825-61-7953,

and 6825-61-6867, 300' to a point at the southwest corner of Tax PIN 6825-61-6867; thence south, with the eastern right-of-way of Brent Street,

10' to a point at the northwest corner of Tax PIN 6825-61-6880; thence

east, 300' to a point at the northeast corner of Tax PIN 6825-61-8830;

thence north, with the western right-of-way of S. Sunset Drive, 10' to the

point and place of Beginning.

is hereby ordered closed, subject to the City of Winston-Salem's reservation of all of its rights,

titles, and interests in any public utility, drainage, landscaping, and the City of Winston-Salem's

reservation of an easement in the entire area hereinabove described for the construction, inspection,

operation, maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, reconstruction, replacement, and expansion of

landscaping, and all public utilities located therein, or to be located therein, including water, sewer

and storm drainage lines and facilities.
