The applicants have provided documentation showing their capabilities to meet the financial requirements and none of the applicants have outstanding debt with the City.

Based on our review of the applications of the companies listed above, it is recommended that these Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity be approved, pending each company's compliance with all City Codes, licenses, permits and zoning requirements.

If all the renewals are approved, the City will have 152 authorized limousines, 120 taxicabs services, and 2 trolley pubs.
