**Summary of Information:**

The owner of Top-Notch Movement has made an application to operate a limousine service in the City of Winston-Salem.

The applicant has provided documentation showing their capabilities to meet the financial requirements and the applicant does not have any outstanding debt with the City.

Based on our review of the application of the company listed above, it is recommended that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be approved, pending their compliance with all City Codes, licenses, permits and zoning requirements.
