After reviewing the scope of work, confirming the relative availability of M/WBE firms, and discussing contract specifications, the City's Internal M/WBE Committee identified subcontracting opportunities in the areas of landscaping, demolition, masonry, finishes, and concrete. M/WBE participation goals were set at 11% and 6%.

The contractor solicited quotes from certified firms for any work for which the company is qualified, including the specific trades listed below. The contractor received quotes from certified M/WBE firms for those in *italics*. Please note, the contractor failed to indicate if the minority firm was not the lowest bidder.

- Surveying

- Site Utilities (WBE Quote Received; Not Used in Bid)
- Demolition (MBE Quote Received; Not Used in Bid)

- Paving (WBE Quote Received; Not Used in Bid)
- Pest Control (WBE Quote Received; Used in Bid)
- Architectural Precast (WBE Quote Received; Not Used in Bid)
- Masonry (WBE Quote Received; Used in Bid)
- Panel (WBE Quote Received; Not Used in Bid)

With its bid, the contractor reached participation of 4.1% with certified minority-owned businesses and 7.7% with certified women-owned businesses. Because the established goal for minority participation was not achieved, the contractor was required to provide the City with Affidavit D, which documents their efforts to reach the set M/WBE participation goals.

In the review conducted by the M/WBE Citizens Advisory Committee, the contractor must accumulate a minimum of 115 out of 180 points to demonstrate a Good Faith Effort. For comparison,



the State of North Carolina requires 50 out of 100 points. The contractor accumulated an average score of **109**, thus failing to demonstrate a Good Faith Effort for M/WBE participation.

Per the City's M/WBE Policy, any bidder not passing the good faith effort evaluation is deemed non-responsive and their bid cannot be considered.
