## **Council Action Requested:**

Consideration of Items Related to HVAC Renovations (Phase I) at the Winston-Salem Fairgrounds Annex Building:

- A. Adoption of Resolution Awarding Contract for HVAC Renovations (Phase I) at the Winston-Salem Fairgrounds Annex Building. (North Ward)
- B. Project Budget Ordinance Amendment to Appropriate Additional Funds.

## **Summary of Information:**

On March 14, 2017, bids were accepted for the purchase and installation of equipment needed to complete the HVAC Renovations (Phase I) at the Winston-Salem Fairgrounds Annex Building. The scope of work involves installing a new HVAC control system for the entire building, improving the dehumidification capacity, and improving the heating capacity with a new boiler system. Below is a summary of the bids accepted:

Deduct Alternate #1 omits the second boiler and second pump (provides heating redundancy) and add Alternate #1 is to install new ceiling tiles where removed for renovations. Staff and the consulting engineer recommend not taking Deduct Alternate #1, but accepting Add Alternate #1 for a net add of \$10,000. It is recommended to award a contract for the purchase and installation of equipment needed to complete the HVAC Renovations (Phase I) at the Winston-Salem Fairgrounds Annex Building to Ridge Mechanical, Inc., the low bidder meeting specifications, for the total estimated amount of \$982,000.

The recommendation to award a contract was approved by the Public Assembly Facility Commission (Exhibit B) at the meeting held March 20, 2017.
