Resolution Authorizing Grant Acceptance and Agreements for Forsyth County Driving While Impaired (DWI) Task Force with Winston-Salem, Forsyth County, and Kernersville (Public Safety Committee Recommends Approval)

Council Member Scippio asked Chief Penn to share a message with the public regarding ongoing scam activity. Chief Penn provided a report outlining common scam tactics targeting citizens, especially seniors, and emphasized key warning signs and prevention tips, noting that legitimate law enforcement will never request money or personal information over the phone.

Ordinance Amending Chapter 38, Article I, Section 38-10(i) Entitled "Possession and Discharge of Firearms" of the Code of the City of Winston-Salem to Allow State and/or Federal Wildlife Officers to Discharge Rifles for the Purpose of Eliminating Deer and Wild Turkeys Within the Boundaries of Smith Reynolds Airport until August 19, 2026 (Public Safety Committee Recommends Approval with Amendment)

Council Member Burke spoke on behalf of property owners near the airport runway, confirming their support for a 12-month extension of the wildlife provision in the city code. Council Member Burke requested a substitute motion to amend the ordinance to extend the provision through August 19, 2026. After discussion regarding safety concerns and the convenience of a longer-term extension, the substitute motion to extend the provision until 2026 was seconded and approved by a 3-1 vote. It was noted that no incidents related to wildlife control had been reported since 2019, and that property owners should be involved in any future changes.

A motion to amend the ordinance to extend the provision through August 19, 2026 was made by Council Member Hall, seconded by Council Member Andree-Bowen. Forwarded to the City Council on August 18, 2025 The motion carried by the following vote:
