Resolution authorizing acceptance of a grant from the North Carolina Governor’s Highway Safety Program to fund the Forsyth County Joint DWI Task Force, execution of an interlocal agreement between the City Of Winston-Salem and Forsyth County, and execution of a Mutual Assistance Agreement between the City, County, and the Town Of Kernersville for continued implementation of the Forsyth County DWI Joint Task Force.

Summary of Information:

The North Carolina Governor’s Highway Safety Program (GHSP) has approved grant award funding to the City of Winston-Salem and Forsyth County for continued operation of a Forsyth County DWI Joint Task Force. This will be the fifteenth consecutive year of funding by GHSP. The Task Force will be staffed by two officers from the Winston-Salem Police Department; one deputy from the Forsyth County Sheriff’s Office; and two officers from the Kernersville Police Department.

Both the grant award of \$73,628 and the remaining 75% match (\$220,886) will be shared by the City and County as follows:

The two officers from the Kernersville Police Department are now funded through a separate grant managed by the Town of Kernersville; however, the two Kernersville officers will be dedicated to the DWI Joint Task Force when the parties (Kernersville, Winston-Salem, and Forsyth County) execute a Mutual Assistance Agreement for continued implementation of the DWI Joint Task Force. Each of these officers assigned to the Task Force is responsible for enforcement of laws prohibiting driving while intoxicated. General funds for this grant (including local match) were budgeted as part of the FY 2024-25 Adopted Budget.
