**Summary of Information:**

The North Carolina General Assembly will convene on April 28, 2020 for the 2020 Short Session of the North Carolina General Assembly (“Short Session”) which is a few weeks earlier than the normal time frame for the short session. Bills during the short session must be non-controversial and must have the unanimous support of the City’s Legislative Delegation. In response to my memo requesting suggestions for legislation for the Short Session, I received a request for one bill and two resolutions. The City also has a pending bill regarding the sale of city property that made crossover and is thus eligible for consideration during the Short Session. The bills and resolutions are described in the attached master resolution establishing the City’s Legislative Priorities and the exhibits attached thereto, which are recommended for your review.
