RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FREESE AND NICHOLS, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT FOR MUDDY CREEK GREENWAY REPAIR PROJECT

WHEREAS, approximately 1,000 linear feet of streambank and channeling along the Muddy Creek Greenway, near Jamison Park and Meadowlark Drive, is severely eroded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem has determined that it is necessary to repair and stabilize the streambank to prevent further damage to the greenway; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work will include but not be limited to background data collection and site assessment; planimetric and topographic surveys; preparing technical memorandum for repair options; prepare drawings, specifications, and layouts of improvements to be constructed; acquiring necessary environmental permits; preparation of construction contract proposal and cost estimates; and provide general representation during the construction phase; and

WHEREAS, 2023 LOBS funds will provide the budget for this design and construction oversight contract; and

WHEREAS, in May 2023, the City of Winston–Salem solicited proposals from various professional engineering firms for the design and construction oversight for the Muddy Creek Greenway Repair project; and

WHEREAS, three proposals were submitted and the selection committee recommends Freese and Nichols, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Freese and Nichols, Inc. for professional engineering services for the design and construction oversight for the Muddy Creek Greenway Repair project, fees not to exceed \$260,000.
