**RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH APPLIED DATA TECHNOLOGIES
FOR THE PURCHASE OF ENDPOINT COMPUTERS.**

WHEREAS, many of the desktop computers used by City employees are over seven years old, are no longer covered by manufacturer warranty, are showing signs of performance degradation that impacts staff efficiency, and are incompatible with current operating systems, security software, and business applications; and

WHEREAS, new desktop and laptop computers will reduce increasing repair costs, enable staff to make more efficient use of existing applications and services, and provide enhanced functionality when designing and implementing new software solutions; and

WHEREAS, this request is to replace an estimated 240 of these existing endpoint computers in departments throughout the City, starting with the oldest computers and working forward chronologically; and

WHEREAS, through a Request for Bid process, using hardware specifications for the City's computing requirements provided by Information Systems staff, quotes were received from the following three vendors:

Applied Data Technologies - \$246,544.15

Key Services - \$296,165.00

Mvation - \$567,409.00; and

WHEREAS, approval is requested to purchase the new endpoint computers and equipment from Applied Data Technologies for a price of \$246,544.15; and

WHEREAS, the Information Systems Department's FY 20-21 operating budget includes funds allocated to cover the cost for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Applied Data Technologies
