The traffic calming plan calls for pedestrian improvements, curb extensions, signs, curb realignments, markings and a multi-way stop placed at Jarvis Road. The West End Boulevard residents have completed all the required steps outlined in the policy and received approval from the Historic Resources Commission, therefore, the Department of Transportation recommends approval and construction of the plan at a cost of \$87,450.
