Summary of Information

In September 2017, City Council adopted a resolution to close and abandon Kerensky Street and a portion of Pershing Avenue. The petitioner, WFUBMC, previously submitted separate petitions for each street. The petitions were combined into one City Council Action item for consideration, with the intent of closing and abandoning both Kerensky Street and a portion of Pershing Avenue with one approval from Council. Language in the CARF, Resolution and supporting mapping included both streets; however, the description of the areas to be closed and abandoned included in the Resolution that Council approved mistakenly omitted the portion of Pershing Street. This Resolution is a corrective action to include the description of the portion of Pershing Avenue that was intended for closure in 2017. This area is part of redevelopment efforts by Atrium Health (Previously WFUBMC).
