Summary of Information:

Renewal of select tennis courts is part of the 2018 G.O. Bonds, which includes resurfacing of tennis courts at Carver High School and Fourteenth Street. The City advertised for bids as a purchase with installation contract, where terms of the specifications requested prices for Option A as crack repair and installation of a patented overlay system, which is then painted and striped, and Option B as standard crack repair using a fill and tape method, followed by painting and striping.

Purchasing solicited and received bids on August 23, 2019, with the summary of bids as follows:

Recreation and Parks desires Option A, which has been used successfully at three other tennis courts in recent years. It is recommended that a contract for tennis court resurfacing at Fourteenth Street and Carver High School be awarded to Quality Seal Coating & Sport Surfaces, LLC in the amount of \$153,380. The 2018 G.O. Recreation Bond allocated up to \$200,000 for this contract.
