Following the January 18 award and in preparation of entering the contracting phase of the project, staff determined that the amount of \$543,722.63 as awarded on January 18 was in fact a subtotal and represented the price of equipment only. The original quotation also included \$83,743.00 for installation and other services, as well as an additional \$11,500 for freight charges, bringing the total quotation for the project to \$638,965.63. Based upon the fact that the original award on January 18 did not include all funds that will be required to complete the project, it is recommended that the January 18, 2022 resolution awarding the contract for turnkey solution services for the WSPD Real Time Crime Center to Constant Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$543,722.63 be rescinded, and that a new resolution be adopted awarding the contract for turnkey solution services for the WSPD Real Time Crime Center to Constant Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$638,965.63. **Committee Action:**
