## **Summary of Information:**

The Information Systems Department manages a data storage network comprised of storage controllers and a large quantity of disk drives distributed between the City's two data centers. These disk drives are grouped into modular disk shelves that contain and protect the data used by the City's enterprise systems and departmental business applications.

Two of the disk shelves—one in each data center—are beyond their fifth year of service and are at end of life with no vendor support. In consideration of the continual advancement of data storage technologies and increased data storage capacity, replacement of the two aging disk shelves is needed. New disk shelves will provide faster performance, enhanced redundancy between the data centers, and improved compatibility with modern application and server requirements. Due to the modular architecture of the data storage systems, staff can follow a planned technology refresh cycle to replace aging disk shelves without interruption to critical City services.

Using specifications provided by Information Systems staff, the Purchasing Department advertised an Invitation for Bid for the replacement disk shelves. Data Network Solutions, Inc. was the only respondent, and submitted a bid in the amount of \$410,762.37.
