Re: Naming of Facility after the Late Mr. Larry W. Womble


We, the undersigned elected officials, are honored to submit this recommendation to name the Pavilion/Overlook at Quarry Park the Larry W. Womble Pavilion and Overlook.


Mr. Womble was a revered member of this community serving as an educator in the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools. He served as an Alderman for the Southeast Ward from 1981 to 1993, in which during this time he led the effort to improve the infrastructure within the Southeast Ward. He talked about the potential of the Quarry as a potential recreational facility early in his career. He was then elected as a Representative to the North Carolina House of Representatives where he served from 1995 to 2012. Among his notable accomplishments, was gaining approval of legislation to compensate victims of the Forced Sterilization Program.

We believe the naming of the above listed component of Quarry Park is a fitting and proper recognition of the long service of Mr. Larry W. Womble to the citizens of Winston-Salem.
