Summary of Information:

During the past two years, our community has seen record rainfall events. As a result, many aging stormwater drainage systems have become damaged and are in need of repair or replacement.

In November of 2020, staff was notified of a sinkhole at the shoulder of Robbins Road. Upon inspection it was determined that a 72” corrugated metal pipe running under Robbins Road had become damaged and was no longer structurally sufficient to support the road. As a result, Robbins Road was closed to traffic (see photos).

Stormwater reserves can be used to fund the design and replacement of the Robbins Road culvert.

The attached Project Budget Ordinance requests transfer of funds, in the amount of \$230,000 for the design and replacement of the Robbins Road culvert.
