## Overview


- State Statutes requires cities to evaluate their existing district boundaries after completion of the decennial Census.
- The goal: compliance with the "one person/one vote" standard
- Redistricting required if any one Ward is beyond +/- 5%
- While the legally accepted minimum standard is +/- 5%, the City has historically achieved a range of +/- 2% or lower. <u>Draft map achieves a</u> range of +/- 1% across all 8 wards.

# Metrics/Methodology

- 1. Keep existing Council Members within their existing Wards
- 2. Preserve the core of existing Wards
- 3. Have 8 Wards within 2% or less population difference of each other
- 4. We currently have 4 majority-minority Wards; the goal is to maintain that balance
- 5. Don't split Census blocks by Ward boundaries
- 6. Ward boundaries should follow logical boundaries

# Public Input & Next Steps

- Staff plans to schedule 3-4 in person drop-in events to offer opportunities to comment on the proposed map
- Utilization of social media and City website to collect comments
- Return to full City Council in September/October with draft map and comments received through public outreach
- To adopt the map, City Council will need to hold a public hearing and adopt a resolution in support of the final map
- After adoption, the City will mail postcards to all residents within the City limits with information about their respective Council Member.
