

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE II, ENTITLED  
“RETIREMENT” OF THE WINSTON-SALEM CITY CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem as follows:

Section 1. Sec. 50-173(h) is hereby amended to add the following at the end thereof:

In the case of a participant who dies while performing qualified military service, the survivors of the participant are entitled to any additional benefits (other than benefit accruals relating to the period of qualified military service) that would have been provided under the plan had the participant resumed employment and then terminated employment on account of death.

Section 2. Sec. 50-181(d) is hereby amended to add the following at the end thereof:

In the case of a participant who dies while performing qualified military service, the survivors of the participant are entitled to any additional benefits (other than benefit accruals relating to the period of qualified military service) that would have been provided under the plan had the participant resumed employment and then terminated employment on account of death.

Section 3: Sec. 50-202(d) is hereby amended to add the following at the end thereof:

In the case of a participant who dies while performing qualified military service, the survivors of the participant are entitled to any additional benefits (other than benefit accruals relating to the period of qualified military service) that would have been provided under the plan had the participant resumed employment and then terminated employment on account of death.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
