Summary of Information:

Approval of the attached resolution accepts a re-amended loan from North Carolina Drinking Water State Revolving Fund in the amount of \$100,000,000.

On September 18, 2017, the City Council approved an application in the amount of \$60,000,000 for a North Carolina Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Loan for the Neilson Water Treatment Modernization project. On October 21, 2019, the City Council approved a resolution accepting an amended loan for \$40,000,000. On November 16, 2020 and June 21, 2021, the City Council approved resolutions accepting re-amended loans for \$60,000,000 and \$80,000,000, respectively. Since this time, the City has been approved for an additional \$20,000,000.

The North Carolina Local Government Commission formally approved the City of Winston-Salem as eligible to receive a re-amended Revolving Fund Loan in the amount of \$100,000,000 for a term of 20 years and 1.02% interest rate on December 7, 2021. Interest begins to accrue from the date of estimated project completion and repayments begin between 6 to 12 months later. The closing fee is 2% of the loan balance.

The Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Utilities Commission has approved appropriations in the amount of \$121,870,000 in previous years. The re-amended loan amount of \$100,000,000 will help bridge the gap between the project budget and loans received to date.
