

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE WINSTON-SALEM CITY COUNCIL
TO CONSIDER NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES DESIGNATION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, that the Winston-Salem City Council will hold a public hearing in the Council Chamber, Room 230 at City Hall, Winston-Salem, North Carolina at 6:00 p.m., on June __, 2024, to consider the following:

National Register of Historic Places Designation for R. J. Reynolds Tobacco Company Buildings 82 and 83, 821 East 25th Street, specifically National Register Criterion A for a property associated with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history due to its significance in the area of industry; (Tax Block 1191 and Tax Lots 00C and 202; PINs 6836-55-5834 and 6836-55-3882). These properties are owned by RDG Acquisitions LLC and North Carolina Department of Transportation.

All parties in interest and citizens are invited to attend said hearing at which time they shall have an opportunity to be heard concerning the foregoing proposed designation.

At the end of each public hearing, the City Council may find that the property meets the criteria for designation and recommend approval of the proposed designation, or find that the property does NOT meet the criteria for designation and recommend denial of the proposed designation.
