Cost of Services
Up to five points were available for Cost of Services with a weight of 40%. The lowest average weighted cost received the full five points and other bids received points based on the amount of the lowest bid. The number of points for proposals other than the lowest bid was determined by dividing the lowest bid by the bid being evaluated, rounding the decimal to two places and multiplying that figure by five.
