On October 17, 2022, The Arts Council of Winston Salem, and Forsyth County- There's No Place Like Home was approved by the City Council with ARPA-enabled funding in the amount of \$1,000,000.

The Art Council of Winston Salem and Forsyth County's project was chosen to be a part of National League of Cities' One Nation/One Project which will bring together 18 cities nationwide. Artists and Community Health Centers across the nation will premiere collaborative artworks on an unprecedented scale. Each site will creatively respond to the single prompt: There's No Place Like Home. The multi-faceted artistic intervention is designed to activate the power of arts and culture to strengthen the social fabric of our nation. The objective is to pilot a national arts and wellness project designed to leverage the proven benefits of arts engagement to foster holistic recovery, well-being, and social cohesion in communities
