**Council Action Requested:**

Resolution to Approve Changes in the State Highway Secondary Road System Within the Existing Corporate Limits of the City of Winston-Salem.

**Strategic Focus Area:** Quality Transportation  
**Strategic Objective:** Improve Integrated Road Network  
**Strategic Plan Action Item:** No

Periodically, the City of Winston-Salem Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) staff review streets located within the corporate limits of the City of Winston-Salem to determine if any streets should be changed from the NCDOT system to the City system or changed from the City system to the NCDOT system. A resolution from City Council approving these changes is necessary to add a street segment to the City system for annual maintenance.

During the construction of the northern beltway interchange with University Parkway, a remnant of University Parkway was disconnected from the rest of the interchange due to its alignment on the west side of the interchange and named “Old University Parkway”. NCDOT and WSDOT have reviewed this segment and found it best served as a municipal maintained street segment. The section in question, and shown on the attached map, is eligible to be included on the Powell Bill for annual maintenance.

The changes reflected in this resolution include:

1. 0.19 mi of Old University Parkway to be transferred from the NCDOT system to the City System

This transfer will occur following the North Carolina Board of Transportation’s approval. A description and limits for this street segment are attached.
