These vehicles look like a bicycle with a two or four seat on the back wheels to allow for transport to and from destinations. The City of Winston-Salem currently has one company in operation with other companies wishing to begin operation. The proposed Ordinance will allow the City of Winston-Salem to better regulate operations of these vehicles in Winston-Salem. The pedicab/rickshaw vehicles offer potential benefits; however, they may also create disruptions if policies are not in place and adhered to. This item was brought before the Public Safety Committee multiple times and concerns were raised about fees, routes, and limits of operation. The Ordinance was updated to include little restriction on operation inside the City of Winston-Salem.
