**RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE CERTIFIED RESULTS OF THE CIVIL
SERVICE BOARD ELECTIONS, THE SELECTION BY THE POLICE AND FIRE
CHIEFS, AND APPOINTING THE FOURTH MEMBER TO THE CIVIL SERVICE
BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Civil Service Board was established by the North Carolina General Assembly effective August 17, 2023 and Winston-Salem City Council adopted an ordinance creating the Civil Service Board on June 17, 2024, and that was subsequently amended on April 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the ordinance, the Police and Fire Departments held their electronic elections from April 21, 2025 - April 25, 2025 ensuring all eligible personnel were able to vote; and

WHEREAS, the certified election resulted in Brett Moyer as the selection by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the certified election resulted in Kelly Emerson as the selection by the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, after the conclusion of the police and fire elections the Chief of Police and Fire Chief met and selected Edward Hosmer as their representative on the board within thirty (30) days in accordance with the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk hereby presents the certification of the results to the City Council as required by the ordinance and which is hereby attached at Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Council acknowledges the certified election results and selection of the Chief of Police and Fire Chief's representative on the Civil Service Board; and

WHEREAS, the fourth member of the Civil Service Board is to be appointed by the City Council, and Rev. Dr. Herbert Miller has been recommended by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the fifth and final member of the Civil Service Board will be selected by majority vote of the other four members of the Board; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem acknowledge that Brett Moyer, Kelly Emerson, and Edward Hosmer have been certified as members of the Civil Service Board based on the process as outlined, and that Rev. Herbert Miller will be appointed to the Civil Service Board by this body, and these four members will be impaneled effective upon execution of their oath of office.
