**Summary of Information:**

City staff recommends the attached ordinance amending Chapter 50, Article II, Sections 50-32 entitled “Definitions”, and 50-62 entitled “Composition; term of representatives; vacancies” to the Mayor and City Council for approval.

As of December 31, 2013, the Winston-Salem Police Officers’ Retirement System (WSPORS) was closed to new members. The Retirement Commission is comprised of representatives appointed by City Council and elected by members of the plan. This amendment will allow employees and retirees of the WSPORS plan to be elected representatives.

This code amendment was reviewed at the February 22, 2018 meeting of the Winston-Salem Police Officers’ Retirement Commission.
