RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ADMINISTRATION FISCAL YEAR 2022 SECTION 5307 JOB ACCESS AND REVERSE COMMUTE GRANT AWARDS FOR ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Urban Area is a direct recipient of the Section 5307 grant funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grant program; and

WHEREAS, the program provides available federal resources to eligible agencies to assist with meeting the transportation needs of low-income populations to get to education and work opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the total available funding in the Winston Salem Urban Area for Section 5307 Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) and American Relief Plan (ARPA) funds is \$125,000 for Fiscal Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (WSUAMPO) conducted a 30-day call for projects between January 16, 2023 and February 15, 2023 and conducted an applicant workshop on January 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (WSUAMPO) coordinated an external review of three submitted proposals for Section 5307 funding by the Greensboro Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, the WSUAMPO has recommended, and the Transportation Advisory Committee approved the funding distribution to each eligible sub-recipient as shown on Attachment A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorize the City Manager to execute contracts with the approved agencies for the Section 5307 funds.
