**Summary of Information:**

The Winston-Salem Department of Transportation (WSDOT) requests to lower the speed limit from 45 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour on Meadowlark Drive due to the major infrastructure project taking place along the street. This speed limit adjustment is intended to be temporary until completion of the roadway project on Meadowlark Drive is completed.

The Department of Transportation has conducted the necessary field investigation and traffic engineering study of the roadway and is recommending the speed limit be reduced to the city-wide statutory 35 miles per hour limit.
